OUR MISSIONS

> The elected parents are your privileged intermediary with the school administration

- The elected parents represent you at official meetings (primary school council, secondary school board and other meetings with academic authorities and the director of the ITER organization).
 - The elected parents facilitate communication and interaction between teaching teams, parent class delegates and all parents.

ACTIONS completed by the Elected Parents from 2007 until 2019 (I)

Obtaining the Abibac (bi-national German-French diploma) in 2012.

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- Obtaining the maintenance of the language section for the secondary diploma (DNB) at the International Advisory Council (IAC) in November 2014.
- Request to the Rector (Highest educational authority in the region) for an EIPACA audit on May 25, 2016.
- Request to the Rector (Highest educational authority in the region) for EIPACA-specific and adapted framework, May 25, 2016.
- Meeting in November 2016 with the General Inspectors of National Education (EN), as part of the audit requested by the elected parents.
- Setting up an English class on Wednesdays for primary school children from CE1 (paid classes managed by IPM). This English class is called English Additional Language (EAL).
- Providing support and accompanying families with students who have special educational needs (PAI, PAP, etc.): interviews with the families and regular meetings with the school management. Requesting and obtaining acceptance of foreign medical reports.

ACTIONS by the Elected Parents from 2007 à 2019 (II)

- Request for improvement of the large parking lot next to the school: painting and marking of parking spaces.
- Installation of protection on the concrete posts in the kindergarten and primary school yard.
- Implementation of the generalized and daily use of the primary school liaison notebook.
- Monitoring of the canteen: request and follow-up of soundproofing work in the canteen, visits to ensure the quality of the dishes, participation in the canteen committee, suggestions for the organization of student shifts, etc.
- Installation of bicycle hoops in the school.
- Project and implementation in 2019 of the re-development of the drop-off and maintenance of the vegetation around the school, to allow better visibility of children and cars.
- Close collaboration with teachers to maintain good relations between parents and the teaching team and help families in difficulty.

ACTIONS completed by Elected Parents from 2007 à 2019 (III)

- ITER's financial support for a secondary school secretarial position in 2019-2020.
- Obtained from the Educational Authorities the necessary post for "Vie Scolaire" in College. Vie
 Scolaire carry out the role of policing and surveillance of the college students.
- Follow-up of the procedure for the creation of the new status of our school, in order to have its
 own rules and to recognize the specificity of our school, since 2018 (still in progress).
- Request for the drafting of a project of establishment since 2016, with its final completion in 2019.
- Doubling of the number of classes in secondary school in "international sections", in 2016-2017.
- Participation in committees for the development of the school project, in 2018-2019.
- Working meeting with General Inspectors of National Education within the framework of the implementation of Local Public Establishments of International Education (EPLEI), December 16, 2019.
- Survey for the attention of parents during the confinement, about the possible return to school.
 Transmission of the results to the school management.


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THE CURRENT ORGANIZATION OF EIPACA IN THE FRENCH SYSTEM

What is an EPLEI? (Etablissement Public Local d'Enseignement International)

The conditions to be an EPLEI:

- ☐ That the school provides schooling for students from Maternelle to Terminale.
- ☐ That the school provides courses in French and in a foreign language throughout the schooling: it hosts French international and/or European sections.

Characteristics of an EPLEI:

- This new framework facilitates the reception and integration of foreign students into the French school system and their eventual return to their system of origin.
- □ If allows French students to practice a foreign language in depth and to reinforce their knowledge of the culture of the language of the chosen section.
- It is a unique legal entity with a unique governance of the headmaster, with a School Board that exercises the competences of the School Board and the School Council.

New Legal Status of EIPACA (in progress)

Before EPLEI status

- 3 local authorities (Commune, Department, Region).
- Currently EIPACA is made up of a school (primary) + 2 EPLE (local public educational establishment; middle school and high school).
- It is financed exclusively by public funds.
- 2 school boards (CA): one for the middle school, one for the high school.
- 1 school council (CE): primary
- No elementary school representative on the school board.
- Complex governance: the Inspector of National Education is the head of the primary, while the head of the secondary is the Director.

With the EPLEI status

- Only one local authority (the Region).
- EIPACA will be a single institution, from Kindergarten (PS) to Terminale/S7 (Grade 12).
- Possible external funding.
- 1 single school board for the entire school (Conseil d'Administration – CA)
- Simpler governance: single management (headmaster + assistants).

Difference of roles: Elected Parents/ IPM

Elected Parents (EP)

- Elected parents are the representatives of all parents and are part of the school organization.
- Their role is well defined in the official texts of National Education.
- Every year, the parents of the school elect their representatives at the beginning of the year (date and modalities fixed by the National Education).
- The elected parents participate in school councils in the first level (Primary) and in the boards of directors of local public secondary schools (Secondary).
- The EPs are there to facilitate the link between the parents and the pedagogical team. Please see slide 13 for the escalation process.
- The EPs are volunteers.

IPM (INTER PARENTS MANOSQUE)

- It is a non-profit association under the law of 1901.
- The IPM is the parents' association of EIPACA, at the service of the whole community.
- IPM's funds come essentially from voluntary family memberships.
- PM supports and finances activities related to educational projects. E.g.: homework club, EAL English courses in primary school from CE1, financial participation (school trips and scholarships), support for the organization of the exam center (IGCSE, BMAT, SAT & DELF, ...).
- The IPM has a social role and ensures social projects within the school. E.g.: welcoming new parents, organization of the cross-country race, class photos, distribution and sale of the Yearbook, collection for the food bank, sale of cakes, books, help at the Christmas market in collaboration with the school, concerts, organization of the fair, etc...
- IPM is managed by volunteer parents.
