ACCREDITATION

EIPACA is a fully accredited OIB, ABIBAC, BACHIBAC and European School

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The International School Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur is a state funded public French school which opened in September 2007. The school offers a challenging, broad-based International or European curriculum, at an academic level equivalent to the French Baccalaureate or A Levels with strength in languages.

School Community

The school was created to educate the children of the ITER(International Nuclear Fusion project) families and many local pupils of both European and non-European nationalities. There are currently 950 students from ages 3-18.

Faculty

 ${\sf EIPACA}$ has 100 teachers of 17 nationalities. The faculty is comprised of qualified teachers with the majority native speakers.

Maximum Class Size: 30 Challenging Curriculum

Students either follow a bilingual curriculum (French and Chinese, English, German, Italian, Japanese or Spanish) or an English European curriculum (80% English, 20% French) leading to the final qualifications of the BFI(previously OIB), ABIBAC, BACHIBAC or the European Baccalaureate.

Activities

All senior high school students follow a programme of personal accompaniment where they can choose from extra curriculum support, careers guidance or a new activity. A wide range of modern languages is offered throughout schooling (French as a Foreign Language (FFL), Chinese, English, German, Hindi, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Russian and Spanish). EIPACA students also participate in a variety of activities such as the Model United Nations, European Youth Parliament, Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme, Student Council and various sports, art and music clubs.

School Calendar

EIPACA has two semesters, beginning early September and early February with a total of 180 school days.

Graduation Requirements

Students must achieve an overall mark of 50% in the European Baccalaureate or 10/20 in the OIB to graduate. They must all follow a core curriculum supplemented by advanced study in their chosen options. Students must attend EIPACA for the final two years in order to graduate with the Baccalaureate.

EIPACA does not measure GPA or rank students.

International Schooling:

- French Baccalaureate jointly designed, set, marked and certified by the French Ministry of Education and, for example, the University of Cambridge International Examinations, Lower Saxony Ministry of Education and the Spanish Ministry of Education
- 6 language sections: Anglophone, German, Spanish, Italian, Japanese, Chinese
- 50% taught in French and 50% in language section
- Literature, History Geography, Maths or Biology taught and examined in relevant language, to a standard comparable to that of the equivalent examination in the home country.
- only 15% of a cohort achieve mention bien or très bien in France
- the proportion of A level candidates attaining AAA at A level is significantly higher than the proportion of French candidates achieving 14 (mention bien) or more. This reflects the difficulty of attaining the higher mark bands in the Bac and the OIB.

Other International Qualifications

The school is an accredited exam centre for Edexcel and students may choose to take International GCSEs at the end of the fifth year in one or more subjects. These exams are optional and fees are applicable. EIPACA students may also take the DELF, KMK, HSK language qualifications.

EIPACA is also an accredited centre (1 of only 3 in France) for Cambridge Admissions tests, which allows candidates to take required tests for applications to Oxford or Cambridge University, as well as for medicine, veterinary science and some science courses in the UK.
